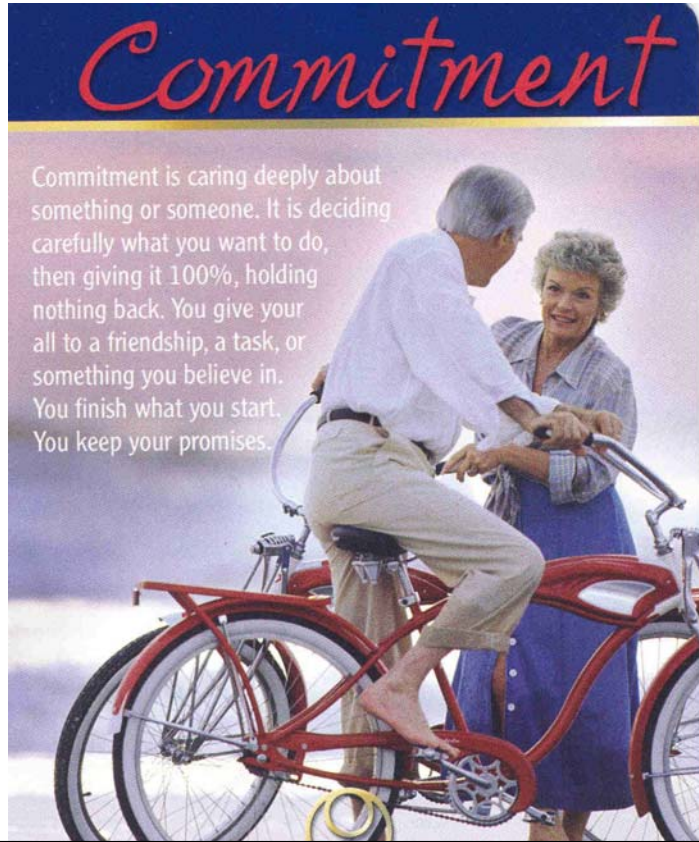


Family Virtues Newsletter
