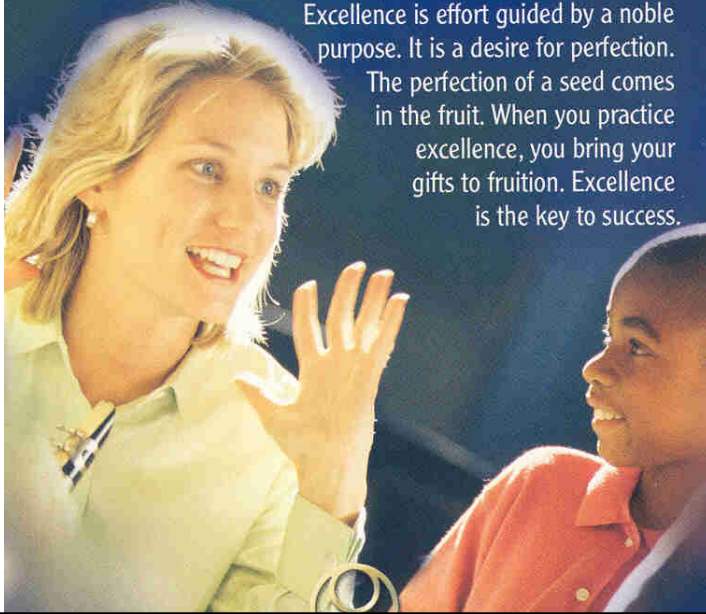


# Family Virtues Newsletter
